# CATHOLIC WOMEN'S LEAGUE HISTORY

#### FOUNDED IN 1906

The Catholic Women's League was founded in England in 1906 by Miss Margaret Fletcher. Membership is Catholic women over the age of sixteen and includes associate members that are non-Catholic.

### The Catholic Women's League (CWL) of Canada

Although The Catholic Women's League had been around since 1906, it would take another 14 years before the Canadian National Council would be formed in the year 1920.

The Catholic Women's League of Canada is a national <u>service organization</u> of women who are members of the <u>Roman Catholic Church</u>, and who work together to promote Catholic values and to carry out volunteer and charitable work. In 2016 the CWLA had about 83,000 members in over 1,200 parish councils across <u>Canada</u>. The League's national office is in <u>Winnipeg, Manitoba</u>; it is federally incorporated, and is a registered <u>not-for-profit</u> membership association. The League does not have registered charitable status.[1]

- First Treasurer: Mrs. F.T. Tighe
