### The Food & Safety Regulations – the Law:

- We can prepare all sandwich spreads without the mayonnaise ahead of time
- On the morning of the Tea party, bring it to the church add the mayo, make sandwiches, wrap and refrigerate immediately
- Sandwiches made with egg, seafood, tuna, chicken – as per regulation safety is best to be done that same day you are serving. Again – make these sandwiches in the church and refrigerate immediately.
